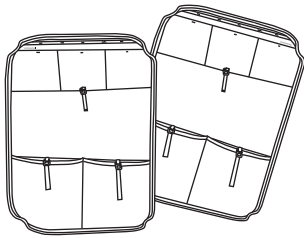

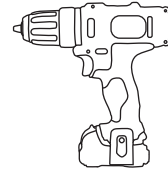


Sheet Metal Screws

Power Drill

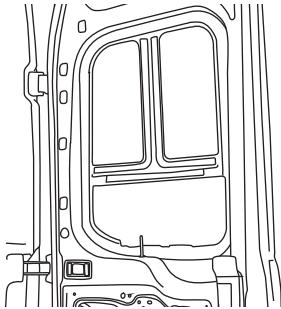


3/32" Steel Drill Bit
with depth stop at 3/8"

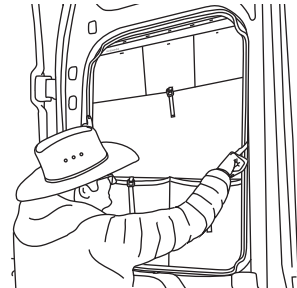


A Friend

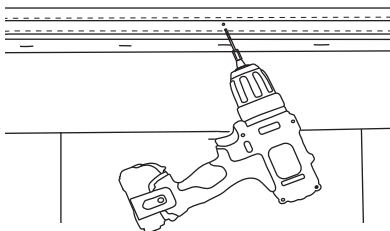
1. If applicable, remove all plastic trim so that your door has the metal frame exposed.



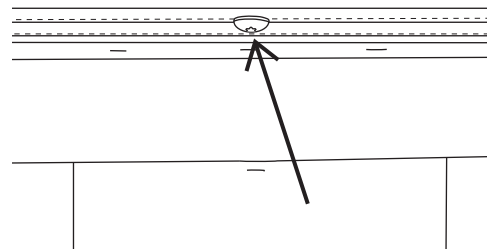
2. Have a friend help you hold up the panel to the window frame placing their hands on the left and right side of the cover. The panel edges **must** fold up against the edge of the window frame.



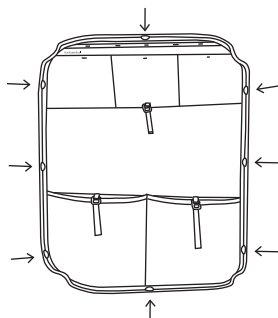
3. Starting on the top of the panel and in the center, identify a spot between the two outer seams and pre-drill a hole through the panel and into the van door on the window frame edge.



4. Drive a screw into the hole, securing the panel in place.



5. Repeat this process on the bottom of the panel in the center, **making sure to keep the panel perimeter folded against the window frame before drilling**. Then repeat this process on the left center and right side center. Add additional screws around the panel edges as needed for a secure fit.



6. Repeat steps 1-5 for the second panel on the opposite door. You will likely have leftover screws. Step back and admire your work!
